
1979 or Forty years ago

MW Richard Mueller-Boerner President of the European Shrine Club 1979

Brief Masonic history, President Richard Mueller-Boerner was born in Berlin on January 18, 1906. Germany. In 1932 he was admitted to the German Lawyers Patent Bar. Noble Richard presently has two offices which practice patent law, one in Berlin and the other located in Munich.

MW Richard was raised to the sublime degree of Master Mason in Berlin Lodge 185 in 1947; he went on to become Master of the lodge in 1954. MW Richard also became the Grand Master of the United Grand Lodges of Germany (VGLvD) in 1961. He is also the Past Sovereign of the Bavarian Conclave 159, Red Cross of Constantine. He is a member of the York Rite, Scottish Rite and The Order of the Eastern Star in Germany. He holds many titles both honorary and active. MW Richard is a very hard working and dedicated Mason in every respect.

Noble Richard was President of the European Shrine Club (ESC) in 1979, which is the forrunner of our Emirat Shrine Center.

Nobles of Emirat Shriners will support the **Berlin Airlift 70th Anniversary**.

Berlin Airlifft 70th Anniversary Luftbrücke Lodge was established on March 2nd 1957. The founding members of Luftbrücke Lodge were milatery personnel who had participated in the "Berlin Air Lift (Luftbrücke) during the Codd War. The first European Shrine Ceremonial was held on 8 August 1953 in Wesbaden with Novices flying in from all over Europe and Sauld Arabia. Although originally attached to the Orient of California for administrative purposes, the AMSRB (Scottish Rite) has flourished since 23 October 1969. BAL Support Role
